Participants may check in to receive their name badge and conference materials at the following times in the hotel lobby:

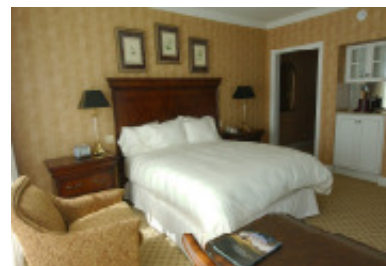
